### **Take care of our washers**

Even though we have large washers and dryers, there is a maximum weight for what they can handle. If it is exceeded, the machines risk being damaged and this entails repair costs for the association.

The most common is that large carpets that are washed are too heavy and then, for example, the glass on the doors is damaged. This happened last in December.

Please respect the maximum weights so we avoid the extra costs.
