Worried about burglary in your apartment?

Right now, there are many burglaries within the Stockholm County.

To reduce the burglaries and increase the security we need to help each other.

To lessen the risk of theft in your apartment:

⇒ Do not keep expensive jewelry and large amounts of cash at home.

Crime preventive tips which makes it more difficult for a thief:

- ⇒ Check your window and door locks.
- ⇒ Mark, take photos of and make a list all your valuables.
- ⇒ Be observant if you see unknown people in your neighbourhood.
- ⇒ Notify your neighbours when you are out of town.
- ⇒ Ask someone to collect your mail or to put it out of sight from the letter box.
- ⇒ Use a timer so the lights in the apartment turn on and off randomly.
- ⇒ Use a timer on a radio set so it's on at random intervals.
- ⇒ Do not record a message on the answering machine saying that you're away.
- ⇒ Do not write on social media (user blog, Facebook, Twitter, etc.) that you're out of town.
- ⇒ Use a call forwarding service to re-connect your home phone to e.g. a mobile phone.

Additional tips:

- ⇒ Use a motion sensor switch with your outdoor lights, especially at the front door and terrace entrances.
- ⇒ Keep garden and work tools indoors or in a locked storage so thieves cannot use them to break in.
