The right waste in the right place

We have an shed where you can drop off smaller electrical items for recycling, such as a toaster, computer or a small TV.

Unfortunately, recently a lot of other garbage has been left in the shed, such as household rubbish, party tents and empty glasses. Ragn-Sells, who are the ones who empty the shed, leave behind what does not qualify as electrical waste.

It also happens that furniture, boxes and other things are left around the association.

When this happens, the association has to hire someone to take care of the rubbish, and it is paid for by our membership fees we pay every month. Money that can go to other things.

If you can't remove it yourself, ask a neighbor for help, wait for a cleaning day or use a service such as Tiptapp.

Extra container!

We know that the containers that are posted on the cleaning days are very much appreciated and we often fill almost two of them of 30 m³ each.

We've previously talked about having more occasions with containers and now it's time for a test.

On Sunday, September 4th at 10:00, a container will be set up in its usual place, in the middle of the association. It remains until 13:00.

However, please note that it is first come, first served. When it is full, no more trash can be thrown at this time.
