Fire alarm

During the fall, it's time to change the battery in your fire alarm. A fire alarm can save both life and property, so make sure it's working by testing it once a quarter!

Cars on our premises

It has become more common for cars to drive into the area. This means both a danger for all children who move around in our association, and also a problem during snow removal when the contractor cannot do their work properly because there are vehicles in the way.

We would like to remind you that parking is prohibited inside the barriers. This means you can load in/out your vehicle, but then it must be moved.

Aimo Park can fine vehicles that are parked without a permit, and if it is discovered that someone does this repeatedly, their parking or garage space can be terminated.

Please only drive in if absolutely necessary and make sure to close the barrier after you.

Fireworks

Keep in mind that the rules for fireworks have been tightened. Show consideration or your neighbors and animals by not using pyrotechnics in our area.
